The total number of visitors to St Helier, King Street for the last 52 weeks is 6,984,266 which is 23.5% up on the previous year.

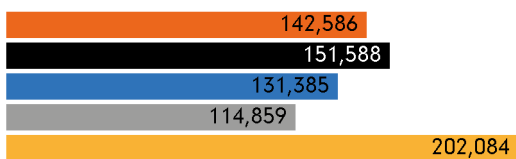
The total number of visitors for the year to date is 4,672,782 which is 26.4% up on the previous year.

The total number of visitors to St Helier, King Street in week commencing 29 August 2022 was 142,586.

The busiest day in week commencing 29 August 2022 was Friday with 25,786 visitors.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Thursday 1 September 2022 with footfall of 3,584.

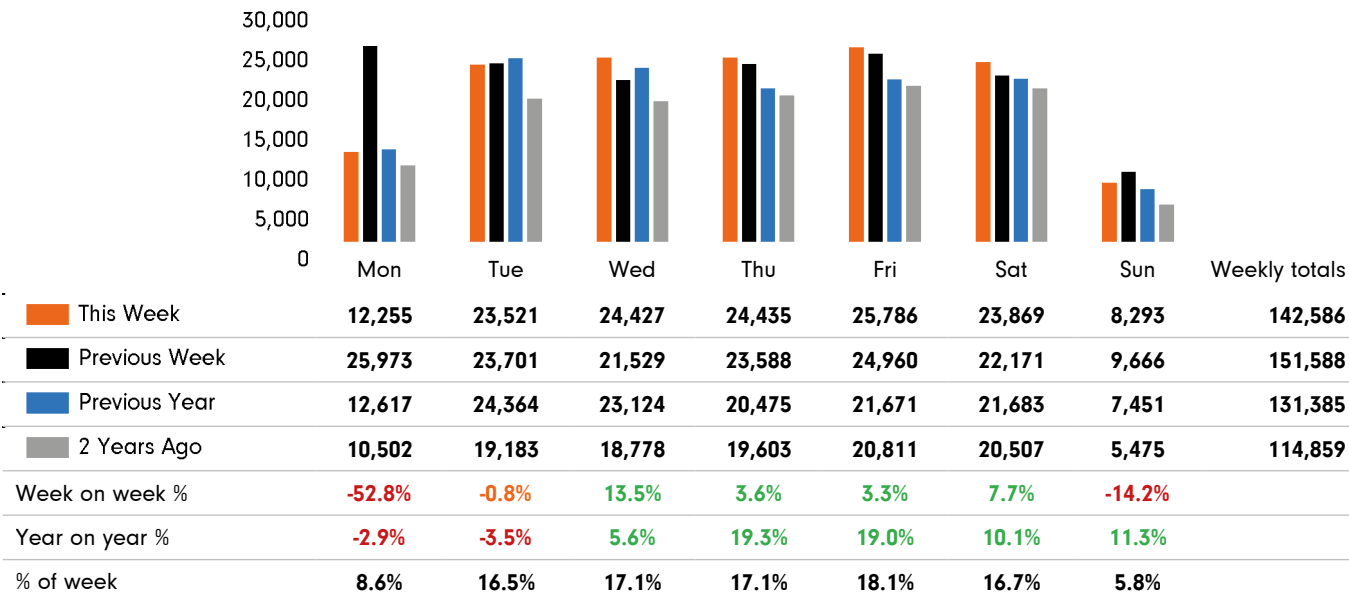

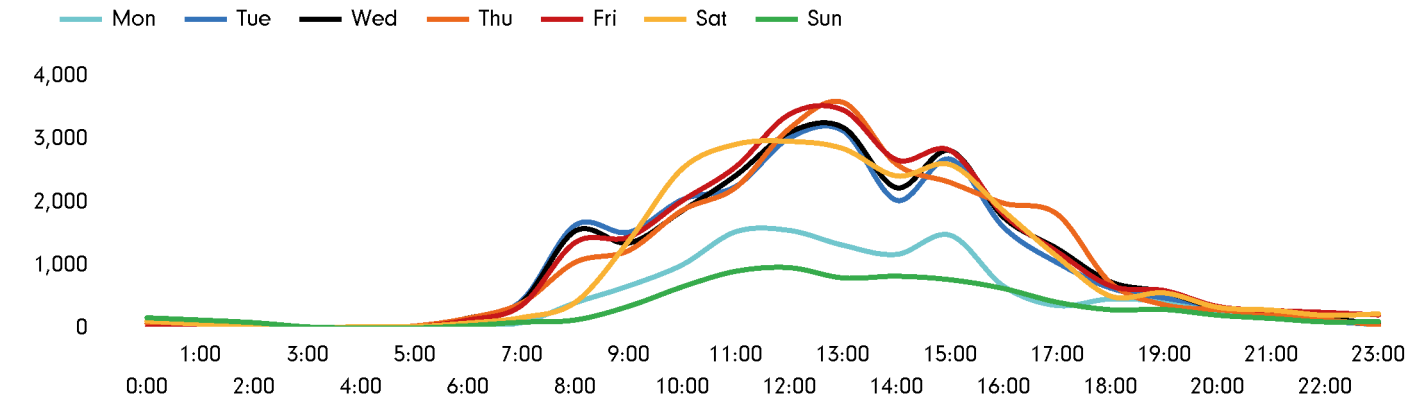

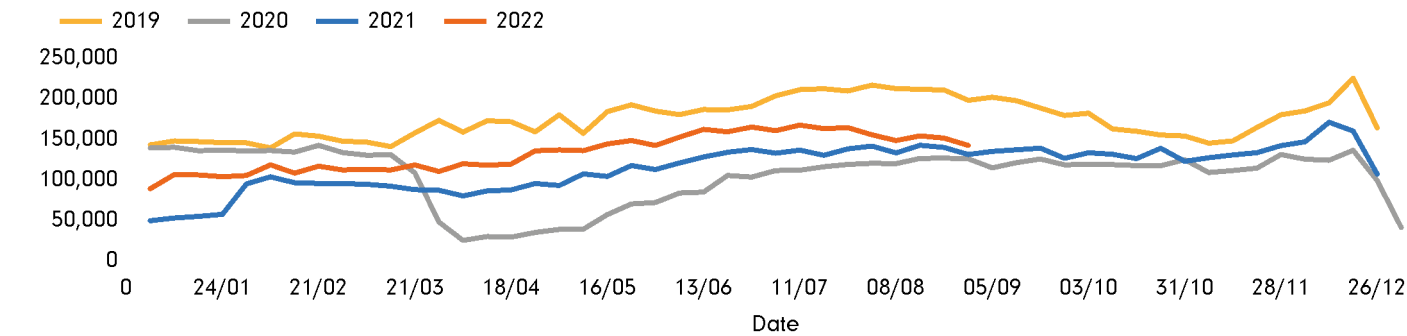
Footfall by day



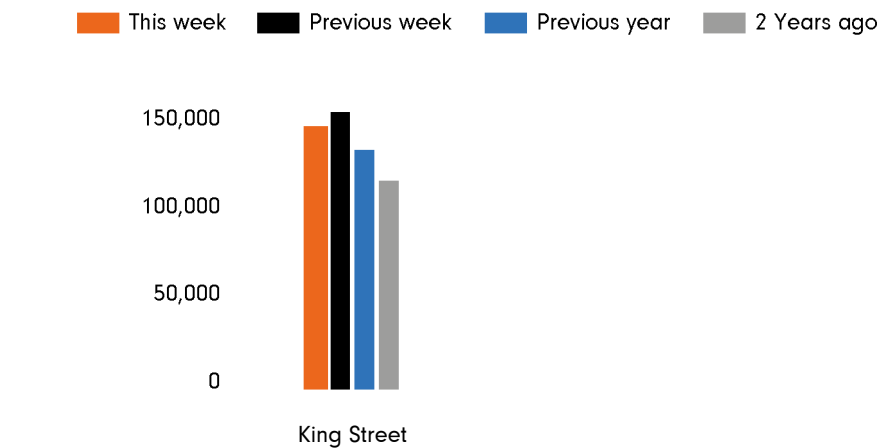
Footfall by hour

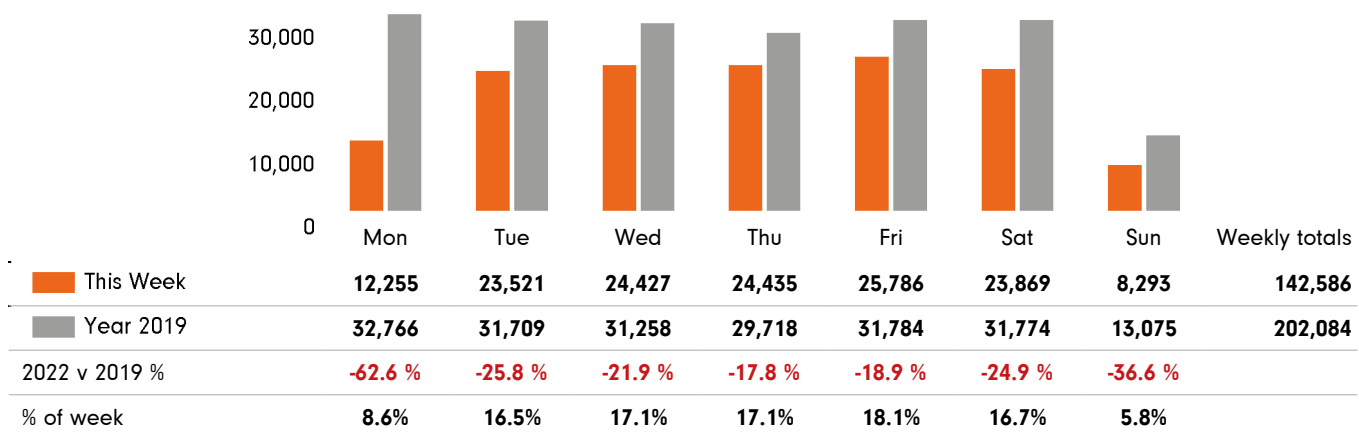
